Dear Pastor,

I would like to take a few minutes to introduce myself by letter. My name is Greg Bach. I was raised as a Missionary Kid in Alaska. I am thankful to the Lord for the opportunity to have been raised in a Christian home with parents who taught me to love the Lord and count it an honor to serve him with my whole heart.

By way of personal testimony, I was saved on May 14, 2019. Ever since that time, I have been involved heavily in the ministry. Whether it was door-to-door witnessing, mass Gospel distribution, music ministry, Seamen's ministry, or preaching, God has used these things to prepare me for what he has now called me to do.

A few months after I was saved, God began to work on my heart about Mongolia. It all started when I watched a documentary about the country. God gave me a burden for Mongolia. I began to pray that God would send forth more laborers to that harvest field, and before long, God answered my prayer by putting it on my heart to go. I struggled with the thought of going so far to a place that is so desolate and harsh, but after much prayer, searching the scriptures, and receiving counsel from Godly men, I accepted God's call to go. Once I did, I began to be at peace with the thought of going and found that the challenges that I was worried about became nothing, and I had the confidence to go forward, knowing that God would go before me and turn mountains of opposition into lessons of faith and confidence in God.

My wife and I were married on June 14th, 2025, at our home church in Oregon. I am so thankful that the Lord brought Grace into my life. We are excited about what God has called us to do, and we are looking forward to serving the Lord together in Mongolia.

We are currently on deputation, raising the needed support to be able to move to Mongolia in April of 2027! We would be honored to have the chance to come to your church and present the burden that God has placed upon our hearts for Mongolia.

- 1) SCRIPTURES: As God promised to preserve His Word, He has kept his promise. Miraculously, and despite Satan's best efforts, we have the Word of God in our hands. All Scripture is inspired by God and is preserved for the English-speaking world in the King James Version of the Bible. (Isaiah 40:8 I Peter 1:25)
- 2) THE TRINITY: I believe in the Trinity of Almighty God, which consists of one God in three persons: The Father, The Son, and The Holy Ghost. (I John 5:7)
- 3) THE LORD JESUS: I believe in the virgin birth of Jesus Christ, his substitutionary death on the cross, and bodily resurrection from the dead. From before the foundation of the world, Jesus was and is our perfect Sacrifice. He fulfilled every point of the Law and God's requirement for atonement. (Matthew 1:18, Matthew 5:17, I John 4:10)
- 4) EVERLASTING JUDGEMENT: I believe in a true and literal heaven for those who have believed and trusted Christ for Salvation and a literal hell for those who have rejected Christ's free invitation to salvation. (Luke 16:19-23, Revelation 21:1-4, 8)
- 5) THE GREAT COMMISSION: I believe the Great Commission of our Lord Jesus was given to the local church, and it is the duty of every believer to obey it by going into all the world and preaching the gospel to every creature. This can be accomplished by going personally and by sending others to go on one's behalf. (Matthew 28:18-20)
- 6) SEPARATION: I believe that separation from the world and its ideology is essential to be practiced if the believer is to maintain his integrity and holiness before God. Dedication to anything cannot be accomplished without separation from something else. (James 4:4, II Timothy 2:4)
- 7) RAPTURE OF THE CHURCH: I believe in a pre-millennial and pre-tribulation position concerning the rapture of the church as the Bride of Christ. We are not appointed to wrath. (I Thessalonians 5:9) As depicted in the account of Noah, God's children were lifted up above the earth for the time of Judgement to return later to accomplish God's will on earth. Just the same, after we are raptured out of this world, we will return after the tribulation with our King of Kings and will with him occupy his kingdom on earth.
- 8) ETERNAL SECURITY: I believe in the eternal security of the believer. This is based on the perfect work of Christ and not our own; therefore, nothing we do will add to or take away from our security in Christ. (I Peter 1:18-19,23, John 3:16)
- 9) CHURCH ORDINANCES: I believe that there are two recognized ordinances of the church: baptism by immersion and the Lord's supper. Both were taught by our Lord Jesus before his death, and both were reiterated in the Epistles. (Matthew 26:26-29, Matthew 28:18-20)

- 10) TONGUES AND PROPHECY: I believe that the gift of tongues and prophecy ceased with the completion of the word of God. The gifts of prophecy and tongues had an amazing purpose in times past (it served to help nourish the church in its infant stage), but we have a more sure Word of Prophecy. We have God's perfect Word preserved for us in the Scriptures. (I Corinthians 13:8-13)
- 11) SALVATION: I believe that the salvation of the soul is accomplished by repentance toward God and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, not by the works of the law. (Ephesians 2:8-10, Galatians 3:23-25)
- 12) THE LOCAL CHURCH: I believe that each church is independent in practice, and each is responsible to God for how it conducts the affairs of the church. The autonomy of a local church is essential to maintaining personal responsibility, vision, and motivation within the body. In the book of Revelation, God spoke to, dealt with, taught, judged, and blessed each church individually based on their needs, faults, and strengths. It is clear that each church is entirely independent from one another. (Revelation 1:20)

## Dear Pastor,


I am writing this letter to ask you to prayerfully consider having Gregory and Grace Bach come and present to your church their calling and burden to reach the Mongolian people. I met Gregory about 5 or 6 years ago through his father, Mark Bach, and his ministry of missionary evangelization in Alaska, Canada, and Creative Access regions. He and his father have been a tremendous help and encouragement to us in our door-knocking ministry and with building and maintenance projects for my own home and also for our church. Gregory grew up helping his father in ministry and was enrolled in their Bible institute. But at the age of 20, he realized he wasn't truly born-again and made the most important decision to accept Christ as his Savior. After this, he spent four more years in the institute before graduating. God has since put a burden in his heart for the Mongolian people. And about 2 years ago, as he made his plans to begin deputation, he asked our church to be his sending church and joined our church by his testimony of salvation and believer's baptism.

This past summer, Greg married my wife's niece, Grace Bond. Grace has been attending our church since she was born, was saved and baptized at a young age, and has been a blessing in our church ever since. She helped clean and decorate the church, sang specials, provided babysitting services to families in the church, helped her parents in foster child care, and was an encouragement in so many other ways. We have been blessed to watch God bring this couple together and call them to serve Him together in Mongolia!

Gregory is uniquely prepared to serve in Mongolia, having been raised mostly in Alaska, and is used to traveling long distances to get to small towns and villages, and has been trained to evangelize in remote areas. His father has also prepared him for missionary service by teaching him how to repair and maintain vehicles and buildings. Mongolia is a field with extreme and frequently changing weather conditions, much like Alaska, where Greg grew up. God has prepared and equipped Greg well for the place He has called him to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Our church is very blessed to be sending Gregory and Grace Bach to reach the dear people on the forgotten steppes of Mongolia! They have a sincere desire to reach lost souls for Jesus Christ, and we ask that you consider partnering with them financially, but also in prayer, as they go to Mongolia.
